CHICAGO, IL - - The Asian American Coalition of Chicago is pleased to announce that it will host its 26th Annual Lunar New Year Celebration, on Saturday, January 24, 2009 at the Hyatt Regency O'Hare, 9300 West Bryn Mawr, Rosemont, Illinois (60018). To celebrate the accomplishments of an amazing year as well as highlight the hope of a united future, this year's theme is titled, "Cultural Threads Woven into the Fabric of a United Future". The 2009 Lunar New Year Gala welcomes The Year of the Ox 4707. The evening begins at 5:30 p.m. with a Cocktail Reception, Open Microphone, and an Exhibition for businesses and community organizations. Opening Ceremonies are at 6:30 p.m., followed by dinner, entertainment, and awards ceremonies, until approximately 10 p.m. The gala is black-tie optional.

An important and popular star-studded event for the Asian Pacific American community and friends of the Asian Pacific American community, each year this event attracts an attendance of well over 1,000 people. Every year a different Asian community takes turn playing host of the Lunar New Year gala. This year it is the Korean American Community, which has thrice before (in 1985, 1993, and 2001) held the gavel for the community's most important event of the year. The Korean American Association of Chicago is providing the leadership this year.

The Asian American Coalition of Chicago, which sponsors both the annual Lunar New Year Celebration and the weeklong Asian American Festival at Chicago's Richard J. According to the latest Census, the Asian Pacific American population in Illinois numbers approximately 428,213, or 3.4% of the statewide population. Approximately 71,469 Asian Pacific Americans reside in DuPage County, comprising 7.9% of DuPage County's population, with the bulk of the other 242,731 residents of Cook County, comprising 4.8% of Cook County's population. The 2000 Census shows that Asian Pacific Americans reside in Chicago in communities including West Rogers Park, Albany Park, Uptown, Armour Square and Bridgeport, and in suburban Cook County in communities including Schaumburg, Hoffman Estates and Skokie.
